Application Process

Grant Information

- 1. Any Rotary Club within Rotary District 7450 may submit an Environmental Sustainability (ES) Matching Grant for up to \$500.
- 2. Projects must have an environmental focus. See Examples and Resources below.
- 3. Each Rotary Club is limited to one grant per current Rotary fiscal year (July 1 June 30) unless surplus funds are available at the end of the fiscal year. Inquire about availability.
- 4. The deadline for submitting applications for the current Rotary Year is June 1st.
- 5. A club donation of up to \$500 may be matched from other sources. See Additional Funding, below.
- 6. Print or type all information. Incomplete applications will not be considered.
- 7. The ES Grant Subcommittee will review the applications as they are submitted. The review process and approval may take up to two months to complete.
- 8. Send the completed application with receipts to TBD
